Renew Your SC Hunting and Fishing License

Sales for 2014-2015 hunting and fishing licenses began in June. You can buy your South Carolina hunting and fishing licenses multiple ways:

- At a regional S.C. Department of Natural Resources office
- At one of the 500 license vendors across the state
- By calling 1-866-714-3611 which is available 24/7
- Online at www.dnr.sc.gov/purchase

Having your state-issued ID ready and a current SC hunting/fishing license that displays your customer ID number will speed your purchase. Residents and nonresidents age 16 and older must buy the required licenses to hunt and fish in South Carolina.

General Assembly Passes New Catch, Possession Limits on Fish

A recent amendment to the South Carolina Code of Laws (50-5-1705) is now in effect:

It is unlawful for a person to take or possess in any one day more than 50 of a combination of spot, whiting and Atlantic croaker taken by hook and line.

Additionally, on July 1, 2014, the daily personal catch limit on flounder changes to 15 fish per person per day and the boat limit becomes 30 fish per boat per day. These limits were passed by the General Assembly in 2013, but implementation was delayed a year.
